ASSESSMENT AT A GLANCE

This paper covers the **key systems that keep South Maui working**: water, wastewater, drainage, solid waste, parks, fire and police. Within this paper, we explore the **current status** of these systems and **ways to make them better in the future**.

Did You Know?

Water



South Maui's potable water is imported from the **Wailuku aquifer sector area (ASEA)**, mostly from the **'Īao aquifer**.

Wastewater



The Kīhei Wastewater Reclamation Facility has capacity to treat up to **8 million gallons per day** of wastewater.

Drainage



In **1965**, South Maui had **199 acres of wetlands**; by 2001, only **83 acres of wetlands** remained.

Solid Waste



South Maui generated **46,044 pounds of solid waste** in 2020.

Parks



South Maui currently has **40 different parks and recreation facilities** operated by the County, State of Hawai'i and private entities.

Fire



Sixty percent of calls to the Maui Fire Department are for **emergency medical services**, while only **six percent** are for fires.

Police



Approximately **36 police officers** patrol South Maui from the police station on Pi'ilani Highway.
