Aloha,

I would like to request that 2.1.11 be revised to say “require” that the north/South collector road be complete before any more development is done in the area between Waipuilani and Kulanihakoi roads.

Creating bike paths and walking areas for the enjoyment of our community should take a back seat to the safety issues created by Namauu place and Hoonani Place having no alternative exits other than South Kihei Road.

I would like to see walkways and bike paths built in these areas, while we wait for the road to be complete. Our children and community have no safe bike paths, walk ways or alternative exit roads.

South Kihei Road also needs continuous bike and walking paths with lights that are adequate to assure safety. 2 of my friends and South Maui community members have been struck by cars while walking in these areas in the last 2 years. Through no fault of their own they were almost killed. We can't just put in these transportation necessities when new projects are being built. We need these in the areas most frequented by everyone who comes in to Kihei through South Kihei Road.
