The plan will include: 1) an inventory and geospatial database of existing trees and canopy cover; 2) an analysis to determine the financial worth of existing trees, considering the replacement value based on size and age of trees, flood abatement, carbon dioxide sequestered, energy usage saved, reduced heat island temperatures, and increased property values, etc.; and 3) a goal for canopy cover increase and strategy to monitor progress and build a program to achieve the goal. Important considerations include providing full canopy trees along roadways, pedestrian and bike paths, and in parking lots.	Project		Mid	MPO	150	County, State
