2.4 Goal | Mauka to makai watershed management

Policies (page 48)

2.4.12 | Protect and preserve open space areas as important assets of the region. Habitat connectivity for native species, watersheds, undeveloped shoreline areas, and other environmentally sensitive areas will be preserved.

Add in “and culturally” after “and other environmentally”.

2.4.12 Should read as follows:

2.4.12 | Protect and preserve open space areas as important assets of the region. Habitat connectivity for native species, watersheds, undeveloped shoreline areas, **and other environmentally and culturally sensitive areas will be preserved.**

Actions: Mauka to Makai Watershed Management

Runoff and Drainage (page 132)

Add, as its own Action, after Action No. 4.04, which reads:

4.04 Regularly maintain and clear sediment basins and culverts in South Maui.

Add as its own Action:

Regularly maintain and clear sediment basins and culverts in the mauka/upland areas within both direct and indirect alignment of South Maui to *minimize/mitigate* the potential damage from downstream flooding.

Not sure what word to use, or to use both words:

- *Mitigate: Actions taken to lessen the severity of*
