DECISION MAKERS

need to take more substantial , immediate steps to ECOLOGICALLY manage rain , storm runoff, including designing PASSIVE LANDSCAPE INSTALLATIONS, such as berms and plantings.

STREAM BEDS, GULCHES.... MUST BE re- routed into a meandering route, to slow down and capture SILT AND DEBRIS,.... BEFORE reaching the beach zones and ocean water.

Finer silts and muddy water MUST BE diverted into SETTLEMENT PONDS and PERCOLATION PONDS, in locations DESIGNED And DESIGNATED BY HYDRO GEOLOGISTS, in order to begin REPLENISHING GROUND WATER AQUIFERS.... locations should be UPCOUNTRY, MID SLOPE and closer to lowlands.

NO NEW CONSTRUCTION must be allowed; MAUI IS OVERBUILT ...we have inadequate potable water, and contaminated ground and ocean waters, with inadequate sewage treatment.
