Aloha

I am asking that the committee revisit Sub Area 4 Wailea. I felt the process did not adequately allow public input or full representation of our community

1. A large number of committee members were missing from the meeting and as a result, I felt the committee was not representative of the community
2. The bluejeans link in the agenda did not work and many people had trouble getting into the meeting. It is likely that some people who wanted to participate were not able to connect.
3. When I could not connect on the bluejeans, I called in on the phone number provided, however no one ever called for testifiers on the phone or asked me if I wanted to testify. I unmuted and was trying to make contact but no one responded.
4. I went on Facebook and put note in comments about the problems connecting with the meeting. Someone did contact me and give me a link that worked, but by that time, testimony on Item B had been closed and I was not allowed to testify.
5. Buck Joiner also tried to join and was on Blue Jeans but audio was not working, I witnessed his frustration at trying to get the Committees attention, and saw when he gave up and left the meeting. As he is a resident of Maui Meadows, I think he was probably there to testify on Wailea sub area 4 as I was
6. There were three written comments received regarding requests for parks and open space in Subarea 4 which were not discussed

I feel that the circumstances made it impossible for the community input of parks and open space in Wailea Sub area 4 to be heard, and that we should have another opportunity for the committee to hear our requests and consider them fully.

Please put Wailea Subarea 4 back on the agenda for testimony and discussion.
