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Almost 600 acres of urban expansion even further up the hill in a new area known as Kihei Mauka. These proposed developments lie within the Kūlanihāko‘i drainage, which already experiences some of the worst flooding in South Maui, [causing road closures](#), [property damage](#), and [major run off along the shoreline](#). Instead of addressing the existing drainage problem, these projects are likely to make it much worse.

South Maui does NOT need more FLOODING and more TRAFFIC!

**CPAC to return the former Mega Mall site to the Residential designation.
Ask the South Maui CPAC to return the Kihei Mauka area to Open Space and
Agriculture.**

Mega Malls are failing across the US, and we need to focus on creating sustainable agriculture, not shopping malls. Maui already has too many empty shopping malls because no one shops in malls anymore. WAKE UP!
